All workshops for parents and child (ren) will be done in Spanish and English, as needed.

Parent attendance with child is required for child to receive Sacrament.

Godparents and Sponsors are encouraged to attend workshops, but it is not required.

Children are expected to attend the regularly scheduled Religious Education/Youth Ministry classes and attend Mass weekly.

To receive the Sacraments of 1st Reconciliation, 1st Eucharist, and/or Confirmation, a copy of child's Baptismal Certificate is required. If we already have a copy, no additional proof is needed.

Requirements to be a:

- **Godparent(s) for Baptism** – Must be 18 years of age or older, actively practicing Catholic, in “good standing” with Catholic Church, having been confirmed. If married, Godparent must be married in the Catholic Church. Godparent must provide a copy of their Baptismal Certificate. Not eligible to be a sponsor - if living in a relationship without the benefit of marriage in the Catholic Church. Proof of Confirmation and/or Marriage in the Catholic Church is required. (No more than two Godparents per child.)

Sponsor for Confirmation – Must be 18 years of age or older, actively practicing Catholic Faith in “good standing” with the Catholic Church and having been confirmed. If married, Sponsor must be married in the Catholic Church. Godparent must provide a copy of their Baptismal Certificate. Not eligible to be a Sponsor - if living in a relationship without the benefit of marriage in the Catholic Church. Proof of Confirmation and/or Marriage in the Catholic Church is required. (Only one Sponsor per child.)

- **No Sponsor for: First Communion Sacrament**
Dress for Reception of Sacrament(s) - Your “Sunday best” is recommended.
